2024 Proposed Budget – The budget is pretty flat from last year. Following the proposal and some questions in September, the budget returned for discussion in October. Paul asked how close we are to this year's budget. Mark answered that we are not in the hole. The club tends to break even on the car show. The scholarship is returning this year; it has been on hold since COVID. The Benevolence gave to the library truck a few years ago and last year, the club made a food bank donation. The 2023 bricks are in Hershey, but they have not been installed yet. Following a vote, the 2024 budget passed.

Christmas Party – the club has money to subsidize the Christmas Party, but the club officially voted to leave that money untouched. Castiglia's is \$23 per person as compared to the much more expensive Country Club. Members agreed that there was no need to subsidize this year.

New Business

Wally mentioned an opportunity for Charitable Giving. Drama students at Spotsylvania High School are looking to raise money for a new sound system and lights for the stage. This is not in the county budget. The Fine Arts Department is trying to raise \$20K for the sound and lights system. Personal donations can be made online. Posed to the club – does HFRAACA want to support Spotsylvania High School Fine Arts Department via the club's Annual Charitable Giving? This discussion was tabled for the November meeting.

Mayo is meeting with HFFI to discuss a mid-century tour of Hanson Avenue Area. This would be in mid-April to mid-May. They may be interested in having 50's to 60's cars parked outside the homes of that era. It would likely be a Saturday/Sunday. The date is TBD. Wally noted that the Northern Neck car show and the ODMA are in the May timeframe and Charlotte is in early April.

Doug Makin brought home a first Junior from Hershey. He talked about his experience – Doug finally had his car ready to show and Mark towed the car to Hershey. There were 1100 cars registered at Hershey, 2023.

Wally put in a plug for judging at a national Meet. He also mentioned the wonderful parade of cars onto the showfield. This is typically from 0700-0930. The next nearby meet is in Charlotte, NC.

The next meeting will be the 4th Tuesday of November, 11/28, at the VFW Hall at 7 PM. The main entrance is on the side of the building. Go in and turn right – the room is 4 steps up.

Ben closed the meeting with a prayer.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.

Reminder - Meeting Venue Discussion – Next Month – November 28th – 7 PM – The meeting will be held on the 4th Tuesday (11/28), rather than the 3rd. VFW building. Both locations (Lee's Hill Community Center and VFW Hall) are willing to make a year long commitment. In November, we plan to vote on a location for 2024.
