MONTHLY MEETING 15 AUGUST 2023

Meeting was held at the Dorothy Hart Community Center. There were 22 members in attendance and no guests.

The meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM by John Garnett, President.

HFRAACA Meet Update: Robert Govoni presented a brief report on the annual show committee progress in finding a suitable location for the June 2024 show. Locations considered included the City Park at Sophia St, Fredericksburg Agricultural Fair Grounds and the Fredericksburg Ball Park. J had shared with Wally, Show chairman the e mail he had received from the city advising there would be a \$1500 charge for use of the park, as well as cost of no parking signs, street barricades and potentially portable toilets. The Ball Park will not know its ball schedule until later in the year so at this time is unable to provide a firm date. Cost of Ball Park quoted at \$2,000. They would like to host our show. The Fredericksburg Fair grounds is available on our traditional date of first Saturday in June. They would like to work with the club to host the show. Final cost to be determined but to be around \$2,000. Carey Leitch is working with fair grounds management to finalize the cost. The Fair grounds appears to be the preferred location. By far, it has the most land to hold show, trailer park and host all aspects of our show with room for growth. By far, it is the easiest set up and tear down of the locations considered. The date is being held pending a final price. An option to hold this date for the club for the next 3 years with an option for 2 more is included in the discussion. There were some general questions and comments.

J suggested that he would like to address a letter to the city expressing the club's disappointment in not being able to continue downtown and with the major price increase in the meeting room we have used since 1957. There was general discussion and agreement for J to write the letter to be reviewed by the president and signed by J and the President on behalf of the club.

July Minutes Minutes had been published in the Magneto and emailed to club members. Copies were available at the meeting. Minutes were approved without additions or corrections.

Treasurer's Report Mark provided the treasurers report. No questions were raised. He did remind the club of the upcoming budget discussion. Budget items should be forwarded to Mark prior to the next meeting.

Sunshine Report J provided the Sunshine Report. Connie has been in touch with all the members known to have health issues. They include Hank who is having chemo treatments, Ken who was supposed to be recuperating at home but was very much in attendance at our meeting as he continues to recuperate from back surgery, Lauman and Francis awaiting test results, and the Hardin's, who are caring for their brother.

Upcoming Events Jeanette reported on the show to be held August 19 at Venture Brewing. This is a benefit show.

David reported on the Madison Taste of the Mountains event September 2nd. He will lead the caravan from Tractor Supply on Rt 3 at 8 am. This is an event which pays the club for attending.

Doug reported on the Ball park outing scheduled for August 29th. We have the minimum number of attendees.

The room is available on 3rd Tuesday. Mark commented that it would provide an area to have a cook out prior to the meeting during a summer meeting if desired.
- John provided information on meeting rooms at Castiglias on Corthouse Rd, Vinnies on Levells and Great American Buffett in Central Park. All have rooms at no cost but anticipate attendees eating.
- Steve B. provided information on the Fredericksburg VFW Post 3103. Their meeting room is larger than present location, has flexible hours and convenient location at 2701 Princess Anne St.

After discussion it was agreed by vote for Mark to secure the Cosner location for the October meeting and Steve to secure a Tuesday date for our November meeting. Unfortunately, the 3rd Tuesday is not available at the VFW.

A final decision on meeting location for 2024 will be determined at the November meeting.

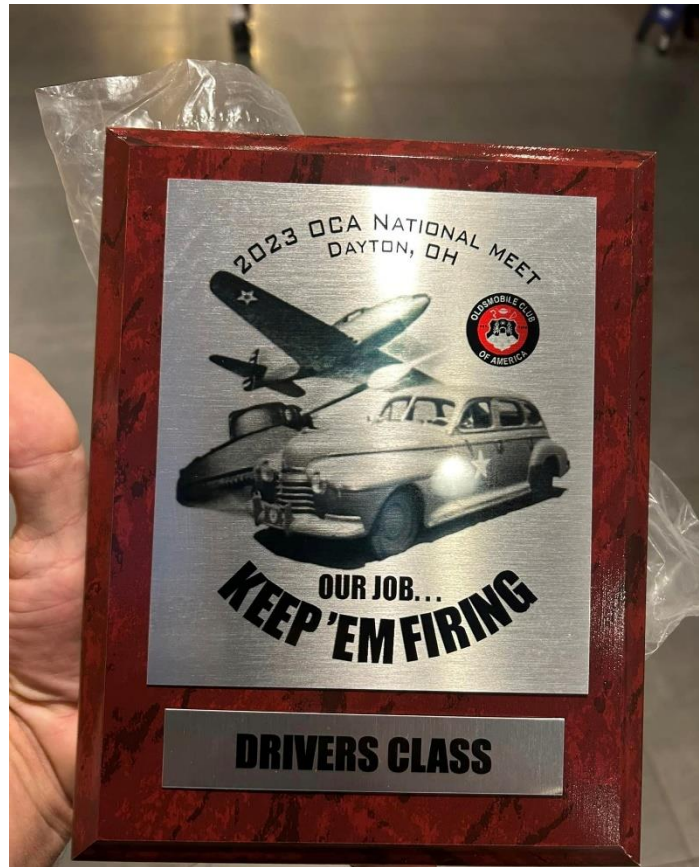

Antique Vehicle Hauling Trailers

Limited antique vehicle hauling trailers/trucks parking will be provided at a one time charge of \$20.00.

You must have your antique vehicle registered for the Friday show and check-off the appropriate area on the registration form for trailer parking to receive a parking permit at the entrance of the parking area. Trailer parking will be clearly marked with signs. Trailer parking opens Tuesday, October 3rd at 7 am. **All trailers must be removed no later than 12 pm (noon) Saturday, Oct. 7th, or they will be removed at the owner's expense.**

Folder Distribution / Registration Pick-Up

Folder distribution will be beside the Hershey Region Main Tent, 11 am to 3 pm, on the Chocolate Field, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Walk-ins only! There will be no vehicle traffic allowed on the Chocolate Field to pick up packets. Friday folder distribution will be at the show field entrance. Vehicle registration and tickets to all events can be picked up at folder distribution.

NOTE: A confirmation with registration number will be provided by enclosing a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Car Corral

Cars for sale must be at least 25 years old. AACA-recognized vehicles only. No Street Rods, trailers, rollbacks, campers or parts are permitted. The Car Corral is for authorized vehicle sales only. A.P.A. Sales Tax License is not required to sell vehicles in the Car Corral. If available, spaces will be sold during the show. Spaces will be approx. 10' by 20'. Spaces will be sold first come/first served. No private jiffy Johns, tents, beach umbrellas, etc. allowed in Car Corral area.

Flea Market

The 2023 Flea Market covers 9,000+ spaces. Flea Market spaces are approximately 10' wide by 30' deep. All vendors will have flea market maps, instructions and windshield stickers mailed to them after September 1, 2023. It is the vendors' responsibility to obtain the Pennsylvania Sales Tax License, which must be displayed during Flea Market sales (<https://mytax.pa.gov>).

The Flea Market will officially open Tuesday morning, October 3rd, and will operate for four days. Vendors may set up on Monday, weather permitting.

Handicapped Information

To reserve battery-operated convenience vehicles for those who are physically impaired, contact **Scooter Bug at 800-726-8284**. You are encouraged to use the website (www.scooterbug.com/AACA) to make arrangements. Personal mobility vehicles can be registered at the North end of the Maintenance Building near the stadium, the West side of the Giant Center and next to the Hershey Region workers tent close to pole #61 on South Chocolate Field. Hours are 8 am - 4:30 pm. No motorbikes, scooters, mini-bikes, Segways, motorcycles, 2 or 3-wheeled bicycles, or private motorized carts (including golf carts) will be allowed to operate on the show grounds for the safety of our visitors and members.

Day Parking and Camping

Fees for day parking and self-contained motorhomes/RV camping in the vicinity of the Flea Market are controlled by the Hershey Entertainment and Resort Company. Shower facilities located in the Maintenance Building will be available for vendors' use at a nominal fee.

Thursday Race Car Condition Run and High-Wheeler Event

The Race Car Condition Run and High-Wheeler event will be held in the stadium starting at 10:30 am on Thursday, October 5th. In the event of inclement weather, starting time will be later and announced on the P.A. system.

The judging of vehicles will begin promptly at 10 am on **Friday**. Any vehicle arriving after 10 am **WILL NOT** be judged. Do not be late! Allow time for traffic flow. **All vehicles must remain on the judging field until released by the Chief Judge, usually 3 pm.**

All registered race car owners will be requested to demonstrate running condition on Thursday in the stadium at 10:30 am. All High-Wheeler owners should plan to participate in the annual George M. Hughes Trophy event at the stadium on Thursday. Spectators are welcome, but must remain in the seating areas. The time for these two events may change due to weather conditions. Please listen for field announcements.

Immediately after the 2022 Eastern Division Fall Nationals (aka "Hershey") ends, we all start wishing it was going to happen again real soon. Well, soon is upon us and we are looking forward to hosting hobbyists from all over the world at what we believe is the greatest week of the year.
